## Congratulations, International Spartans!!!

This May 6, at the Expo Hall at the Florida State Fairgrounds, the UT's 156th commencement will have two ceremonies, one will take place at 9:30 AM, and the second one at 2 PM.

We are extremely proud and excited for the graduation of more than 90 international students from around 40 different nationalities this Spring 2023. At least 56 of them are applying for OPT. We will keep processing OPT requests for this semester graduates until June 29, 2023.







**Post-Completion Optional Practical Training (OPT)** is a temporary work authorization that gives F-1 students an opportunity to apply knowledge gained in the classroom to a practical off-campus work experience immediately following graduation in the student's major field of study for a maximum duration of one year per educational level.

Authorization is granted by the U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Service (USCIS) and USCIS requires an OPT endorsed I-20, issued and signed by your DSO no more than 30 days from the submission of your application.

The main reason for OPT denials is submitting the application to the USCIS without the endorsement of your International Student Advisor reflected in your I-20. ## the tip of this month



If your visa is expiring before your graduation and you wish to renew it, you must consider these 4 important facts:

- 1. You can remain the US with an expired visa if your I-20 reflects that you remain in F-1 status.
- 2. You can try to renew your visa up to 6 months before it expires.
- 3. You cannot renew your visa in the US. You need to go to your home country and apply there.
- 4. Visa renewal applications during your last semester or during OPT are often denied

Please consult with your International Student Advisor before starting any visa renewal process.
