

# NEED YOUR I-94 FORM?

If a school, local, state or federal agency requests your I-94 information, go to <https://i94.cbp.dhs.gov/i94/#/home> to print it out. Click on the “Get Most Recent I-94” tab. In the next window, you will be required to read and accept terms of the website (“Consent & Continue”).

## You will need to provide:

1. First (Given) Name – as it appears on the passport/visa.
2. Last (Family) Name/Surname – as it appears on the passport/visa.
3. Birth Date – Day/Month/Year (i.e. 18/MARCH/1991).
4. Passport Number – as it appears on the passport/visa.
5. Passport Country of Issuance – country of citizenship as it appears on the passport.
6. Click “NEXT”.
